We provide membership levels in four categories: Contractors, Engineering & System Users, Business Partner, and Transportation Industry Associations. Memberships are annual. Details of each category are included below:

Contractor Membership Levels

Level		Membership Cost
Platinum	Annual revenue of \$100 million or greater	\$4,500
Gold	Annual revenue of \$25-\$100 million	\$2,500
Silver	Annual revenue under \$25 million	\$1,000

Federal, CDOT, Denver and/or RTD certified DBE/ESB/SBE/EBE and M/WBE are eligible for a 20 percent membership discount in all categories.

Engineering & System User Membership Levels

Level	Description	Membership Cost
Platinum	50+ employees located in Colorado offices	\$4,500
Gold	20-50 employees located in Colorado offices	\$2,500
Silver	< 20 employees located in Colorado offices	\$1,000



Bronze	<10 employees located in Colorado offices	\$500

Level	Description	Membership Cost
Business Partners	Chambers of Commerce/Economic Development Organizations	\$1,250
Regional Partners	Organizations outside Metro Denver	\$500
Individual	Person not affiliated with a firm	\$150
Cooperating Agency	Agency with similar goals, where collaboration is mutually beneficial	Reciprocal membership
